Shopfloor positions at H&T Battery Components Waterbury

Description:

From time to time we have openings for 1st and 2nd shift Press Operators and Packers. Check out the brief descriptions below:

- Production (Press) Operator
 - Review the operator instruction sheet, check router for proper materials and requisition the material from the Waterspider.
 - Maintain product segregation per the work instructions. Properly fill out routing tickets and place with work.
 - Follow the autonomous maintenance check list looking for any apparent need for machine repair before operation.
 - Use the overhead crane to install material on the payoff reels. Monitor the material on the payoffs so the material does run out.
 - Start the press and inspect the first run pieces to ensure conformity with specifications.
 - Monitor production performing visual and dimensional measurement inspection at prescribed intervals during production. Check for defects according to the quality plan.
 - Use precision measuring instruments to ensure product conforms to specifications. Follow established procedures for disposition of nonconforming products.
 - Perform basic troubleshooting and report issues to the Toolmaker.
 - Transfer the product to the next process using a hand truck or its equivalent.
 - Perform general housekeeping duties in your assigned area as needed and directed by the Toolmaker or V.S. Leader.
 - Follow company policies, procedures and comply with standard safety rules and regulations.

- Can Coating Operator
 - Review router, checking part and lot numbers against parts to be coated. Ensure proper labels are printed
 - Perform the inspections according to the quality plan.
 - Able to enter quality inspection into the SPC system.
 - Start machine and inspect first run product to ensure conformity with specifications. Use gram scale to ensure proper amount of graphite paint was applied in accordance with specifications. Use digital calipers to measure paint coverage.
 - Visually check machine for any apparent need for repair or cleaning. Inspect spray nozzle for wear. Perform machine setup operations. Set machines to proper settings for production.
 - Continuously monitor machine operations. (continued)



- Perform regular maintenance of machines.
- Perform similar and related duties as assigned or as position dictates.
- Follow all safety rules and regulations. Ensure proper housekeeping of area.

- Cleaning Machine Operator
 - Review router, checking part numbers against product to be cleaned. Ensure proper labels, and boxes are available for packaging/catching.
 - Complete checks of the cleaning solution and make adjustments as needed.
 - Set cleaning machine and cob drier parameters according to the cleaning matrix.
 - Drain and clean tanks as needed.
 - Using lift, load parts into machine for cleaning. Inspect cleaned parts to ensure part has been properly cleaned to specifications.
 - Follow all safety rules and regulations. Ensure proper housekeeping of area.

- Can Coating Packer
 - Tape and properly label cartons. Transfer cartons to skids.
 - Inspect product for defects which include the can and coating per HTW's quality procedures.
 - Move full skids to staging area.
 - Follow all safety rules and regulations. Ensure proper housekeeping of area.

- Cleaning Machine Packer
 - Receive verbal instructions from cleaning machine operator. Set scale following specified procedures to correctly weight boxes.
 - Tape and properly label cartons. Transfer cartons to skids. Use wrapping machine to wrap full skids, ensuring safe transport of product.
 - Load box maker with the appropriate size cartons for each product.
 - Follow all safety rules and regulations. Ensure proper housekeeping of area.
